HUMAN TRAFFICKING

"Learn to do right; seek justice. Defend the oppressed

Take up the cause of the fatherless;

plead the case of the widow." - Isaiah 1:17

Although outlawed centuries ago, slavery is still very much alive. There are more people in slavery in the world today than at any other time in history. In fact, Slavery occurs in almost every country in the world, even in our very own backyard. Portland, for example, is one of the hot spots in the US, but the truth is it is everywhere.

As a church, we many times stand dumbfounded as to what to do about it, but the prophet Isaiah gives us a great blueprint. He uses five action verbs to challenge us to not only understand the plight of those caught in slavery, but also how to put our faith into action.

- 1) LEARN The issue of trafficking is a hidden one. We must begin by learning about the issues; the facts, what is actually happening in the world as well as locally.
- 2) SEEK We need to seek Justice. We cannot rely on others for this, but we need to personally get a deeper understanding of these issues and problems and what can possibly be done to solve or eradicate them, thus making justice prevail!
- 3) DEFEND Next we need to take action, to stand in the gap between the oppressor and the oppressed. The justice sought must translate into action. DEFEND means to "to resist an attack... to protect from harm" and most likely will come only with a personal sacrifice of time, money and more... Two specific outworkings of this are:
- 4) TAKING up the cause of orphans and... 5) PLEADING the case for widows. Statistics show that 80% of the world's slaves are women and children, and, as such, they are vulnerable to all manner of crimes. Therefore, as believers, we must take a stand!

FACTS ABOUT TRAFFICKING

TRAFFICKING IS...

to be taken against your will, bought, sold or transported into slavery for sexual exploitation, sweat shops, child brides, circuses, sacrificial worship, forced begging, sale of human organs, farm labor, domestic servitude, restaurant workers etc. 80% of all victims are women and girls, 50% are children.

TRAFFICKING IS...

where family members and friends deceive parents to release their children or sell them for as little as \$20 each, selling them to local gangs or serious organized international trafficking rings

TRAFFICKING IS...

growing. 4-27 million men, women and children are trafficked across borders and within their own countries every year. More than one person is trafficked across a border every minute, which is equivalent to 5 jumbo jets every day. Trafficking generates twice the worldwide revenue of Coca Cola.

TRAFFICKING IS...

where victims usually suffer repeated physical abuse, fear, torture and threat to families to first break their spirits and then turn them into saleable commodities. A person can be sold and trafficked many times over.

TRAFFICKING IS...

everywhere! In the US, over 50 000 people are abused in trafficking. 50% in prostitution. Portland is one of the capitals of prostitution in the US. Given the number of slaves in the US, chances are that someone you pass on a weekly basis is a slave or uses slaves.
